Objects on display tell stories of the trade and the exchange of ideas that were the result of international commerce, as well as the flow of religions and faith through Asia.

Generally, our food are vegetarian friendly except for 2 dishes. There will be components of peanuts, milk, soy and eggs in most dishes.
